For safety reasons, we are trying to allow a 72 hour wait period after folks depart before our usual thorough cleaning of the cabins for our next group.

Guests are asked to please bring your own pillows.

While guests are on site, we will need to limit our interaction, but will make sure that garbage is picked up. We will not be recycling during this time.

The playground will be off limits – we cannot possibly sanitize this often enough.

Canoes, paddles, peddle boats, life jackets and beach toys etc. will not be available. Feel free to bring your own.

The fish cleaning shack will be open, cleaned regularly and our usual supply of Lysol will be there.

Campfires are allowed, but all current Covid rules are expected to be adhered to.

Payment is appreciated by e-transfer, but cheque and cash are also accepted.

Restrictions and information are still changing by the day and we are trying to filter and adapt the best we can. With all of the uncertainty, the safety of our guests and our family is the top priority.
