But, we need to do our best to make sure that our guests and our family remain safe. To that end, we need to make some changes, at least for the short term.

For safety reasons, we are trying to allow a 72 hour wait period after folks depart before our usual thorough cleaning of the cabins for our next group.

Guests are asked to please bring your own pillows.

While guests are on site, we will need to limit our interaction, but will make sure that garbage is picked up. We will not be recycling during this time.

The playground will be off limits— we cannot possibly sanitize this often enough.

Canoes, paddles, peddle boats, life jackets and beach toys etc. will not be available. Feel free to bring your own.

The fish cleaning shack will be open, cleaned regularly and our usual supply of Lysol will be there.

Campfires are allowed, but 2 meter social distancing will be expected.

Ontario now allows 10 people inside per gathering and 25 people outside, with 2 meter social distancing rules and/or face masks still in effect.

Payment would be appreciated by e-transfer, but cheque and cash are also accepted

Restrictions and information are changing by the day and we are trying to filter and adapt the best we can. With all of the uncertainty, the safety of our guests and our family is the top priority. For most folks, these uncertain times will not be an ideal holiday, so we absolutely understand if you would like to cancel.
